OUR LADY OF DONCASTER – DATES FOR YOUR DIARY

At St Peter-in-Chains, Doncaster we have, as you know, the re-ordered Shrine of Our Lady of Doncaster. In May and June there are to be two events connected with the Shrine. Details of these are given below and we very much hope that you will be able to come and celebrate with us on one, or both, of these occasions.

Saturday, May 20th

In Our Lady's Month of May the Guardians of the Shrine of Our Lady OF Doncaster will be launching a newly-written Shrine Guide Book. This has been written by the designer of the Shrine, Mr Rod Flint, and produced by the Guardians of the Shrine. It not only provides a guide to the present Shrine but also includes a history of the pre-reformation shrine that was established in the 14th century and which became the 5th most important

June 4th is the Feast Day of Our Lady of Doncaster, but as it falls on a Sunday this year the celebrations will take place on Saturday June 3rd. There will be Mass at 12 noon, followed by 5 decades of the Rosary said at the Shrine. Finally, there will be complimentary tea/coffee and cake in the Hall.

These two events are for everyone. All the Friends of the Shrine and anyone who has an interest in and/or devotion to Our Lady of Doncaster will be most welcome. The pandemic has meant that we were not able to celebrate the Feast properly for the last 3 years so it would be very good to see our "old" friends once again.
